Field Trauma Kit Checklist

The Field Trauma Kit is intended to treat and stabilize life threatening traumatic injuries using the *MARCH* assessment and treatment algorithm. This kit is meant to treat severely injured individuals, and to stabilize their injuries in preparation for a rapid casualty evaluation.

The items contained in this kit require specialty training before attempting to use; therefore the use of this kit must be limited to individuals who have completed the "Stop The Bleed" course as the minimum baseline of training.

This kit is intended to support high-adventure excursions and treks where advanced medical care may not be immediately available.

We encourage you to seek training from a medical professional as part of the "*Stop The Bleed*" program or enroll in a Wilderness First-Aid course.



A *Field Trauma Kit* should include:

- four pair of nitrile gloves
- trauma shears
- Rescue Breathing mask
- Oral Pharyngeal Airway
 - large - 1
 - medium - 1
 - small - 1

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- two Combat Application Tourniquet (CAT)
- one Special Operations Tourniquet - Wide (SOFT-W)
- one Stretch Wrap And Tuck Tourniquet (SWAT-T)
- "Tegaderm" clear dressings
 - small - 6
 - medium - 4
 - large - 2
- one SAM splint 18 inches
- one Israeli bandage - large
- one USGI-type field dressing
- two packages "Combat Gauze"
- two 2 inch rolls "Krinkle gauze" or "Z-fold" gauze
- one large sterile dressing (burn dressing)
- five 4 x 4 sterile gauze pads
- five 3 x 4 "Adaptic" dressings
- one roll 2 inch wide silk medical tape
- one emergency mylar blanket

This Kit should be carried by a trained member of the Team so that it is always available for use while on high adventure excursions or treks.
